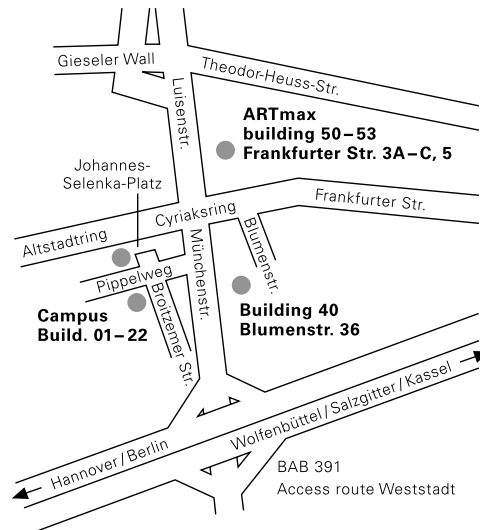

**HBK BRAUNSCHWEIG** The Braunschweig University of Art is unique to combine art, design and sciences and is the second largest art academy in Germany with about 1.200 students. Forward-looking, it links a long history reaching back to the year of 1842 to a modern orientation and a broad range of subjects. As one of the first art academies of Germany, the HBK has changed its study courses to Bachelor and Master degrees to stress its international orientation. This was made in consideration of the particular conditions for the art and design related study courses and by finding modified solutions. For this reason, Fine Art continues to be offered as a diploma study course, which is also certified with the reformed curriculum. \_\_\_ What is characteristic about research and education at the HBK is the equal coexistence of art, design and sciences. In the numerous courses, the specialisations are interacting. Together with the excellently equipped workshops and laboratories and the generous space on offer, a productive medium for interdisciplinary projects is the result. 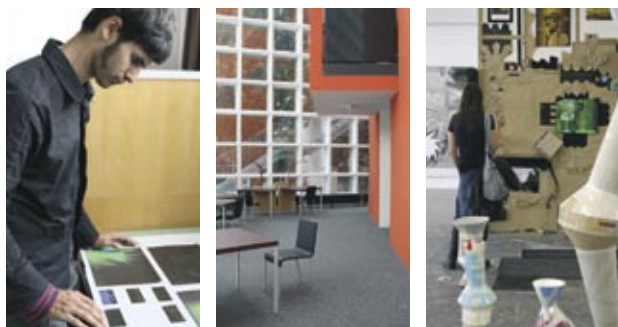
